

LOCAL GREEN SPACES

COMMUNITY SURVEY

Now closed

As part of our work in developing the Aldbourne Neighbourhood Development Plan, local people have suggested some small areas of land that they think could benefit from being formally designated in the Plan as 'Local Green Spaces' (LGS), providing them with protection from any future development. LGS designation "*allows communities to identify and protect green areas of particular importance to them*"

The legislation on LGS is very strict; the spaces above are those that we have assessed and found to be potentially compliant with national planning policy criteria. To our knowledge there is no current intention to develop these sites. (Other spaces, such as the green space along the Bourne and Palmers Field, can be included in the Plan in other ways, for example as part of the Parish's green network.)
